



#32-305 Concentrated Concrete Cleaning Detergent

This concentrated concrete cleaning detergent is a highly effective non-acidic cleaner for horizontal concrete and masonry surfaces. The cleaning detergent can be successful in the removal of light to moderate atmospheric soiling and certain other surface deposits. This product is often used on sidewalks, drive-through areas and parking lots where a non-hazardous labeled cleaning product is an asset. This product is recommended for cleaning prior to sealing or re-sealing the concrete surface.

PREPARATION

Provide protection for foliage and pedestrian traffic. Test all non-masonry surfaces for any possible adverse reactions. Protect all surrounding areas from possible damage, which might occur from spillage or drift during usage.

All projects should start with a test application to determine the suitability of the cleaner and the required dilution ratio. Test areas of at least 10 square feet are recommended and should involve the most severely contaminated location. Allow the test area to dry prior to determining the acceptability of the cleaner and cleaning method.

APPLICATION

For optimal coverage the material should be properly diluted in a 4 to 1 ratio producing 5 gallons of product. This concrete detergent is most effective when applied by low-pressure spray. Brush application and agitation may prove helpful on some surfaces. Dwell times may vary from five to thirty minutes. Removal of the cleaning detergent and contaminant can be accomplished most successfully with a pressure washer. A thorough rinsing is required to avoid a potential slipping hazard when the surface becomes wet from rain



or other means. Stubborn deposits may require spot treatment of the concentrated detergent.

It is advised to keep work area wet to not allow detergent and residual material to dry. This makes it easier to rinse.

SAFETY

All applicators must wear OSHA recommended protective equipment. Concrete cleaning detergent contains strong alkaline materials. Avoid contact with skin, eyes and clothing. Diluted and undiluted product can cause burns. Keep out of the reach of children. Do not ingest or inhale the detergent, modify the detergent with any material other than water or use the cleaner for any non-recommended purpose. Refer to the proper MSDS Sheet for treatment of persons exposed to or reacting to the detergent.

FIRST AID

Inhalation: Remove to fresh air. If not breathing, give artificial respiration. Call physician immediately.

Eyes or Skin: Flush with water for 15 minutes. Remove contaminated clothing.

Ingestion: Do not induce vomiting. Drink large amount of water and seek medical attention.
